"Back to Nature? Sex/Gender, Language and the New
Biologism

Abstract: Both in the academy and in the world beyond it, we have recently seen a resurgence of interest in the idea that male-female differences, including those observed in the domain of language and communication, are biologically-based rather than socially constructed.
