Irmgard Marboe is Associate Professor at the Department of European, International and Comparative Law at the Law Faculty of the University of Vienna. She studied law and languages at the University of Vienna (Austria) and at the Universidad Complutense de Madrid (Spain).

After her doctorate in European Community Law (1994) she focused on international law and more particularly on international investment law. Her post-doctoral thesis ("habilitation") on compensation and damages in the practice of international courts and tribunals was published in German and in English (2009).

Prof. Marboe has participated in the perennial research project of the "Vienna International Christian-Islamic Round Table" since 2000. She published numerous articles analysing the relationship between international law and Islamic law and tradition. In 2007, she became the director of the "Vienna International Christian-Islamic Summer University" which took place in 2008 and will again be held in July 2010.

Furthermore, Prof. Marboe is the head of the Austrian National Point of Contact for Space Law of European Centre for Space Law and has been elected to be the chairperson of the Working Group on "National Space Legislation" of the Legal Subcommittee of UN Committee for the Peaceful Use of Outer Space between 2009 and 2011.

Her current teaching activities include courses and seminars on general international law, international economic law, international courts and tribunals, and space law. Ms. Marboe speaks German, English, French, Italian, and Spanish.
