The Research Group on Applied Mathematics and Modeling of the Faculty of Mathematics at the University of Vienna invites applications for a

PhD-student position.

Starting is possible anytime up to October 2020, at the latest.

The position is for three years and involves no teaching. The annual gross salary is approximately 31 k€. The appointment is funded by a FWF grant.

The thesis project will focus on variational models and methods in Materials Science and evolution equations. Applicants must have or be close to obtain a Master in Mathematical Sciences. A strong background in calculus of variations and/or applied analysis is preferred. The position is associated with the enrolment in the PhD program in Mathematics at the University of Vienna.

Candidates are requested to e-mail their application including a detailed CV as a single pdf file to appl.math@univie.ac.at and to indicate names and full contact addresses of two references (no letters required).

Applications will be assessed continuously, until the position is filled. A first evaluation round will start on **April 20th**, **2020**.
