- Oriental Orthodox churches (281.6-281.7)
- Assyrian Church of the East (281.8)
- **Orthodox (a.k.a. Eastern Orthodox) churches (281.9)**

*Note: St. Thomas Christian churches cut across the above classification; comprehensive number at 281.54**

**Expansion*

281.94-.99 Specific autocephalous, arbitrary autocephalous, autonomous, independent churches

Add to base number 281.9 notation 4-9 from Table 2 **for the country of the seat of the church**, e.g., Russian Orthodox Church, Russian Orthodox Church Outside Russia 281.947, Orthodox Church in America 281.973; . . .

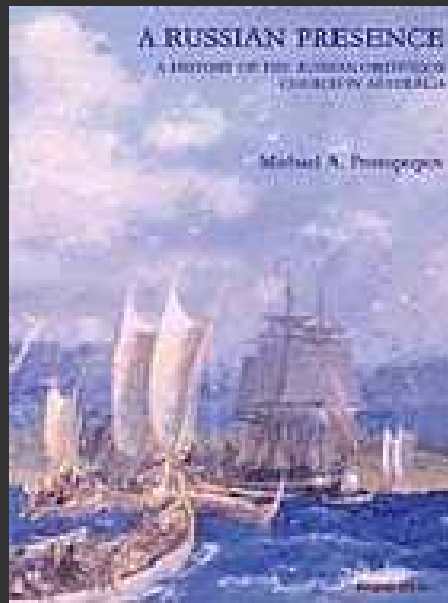

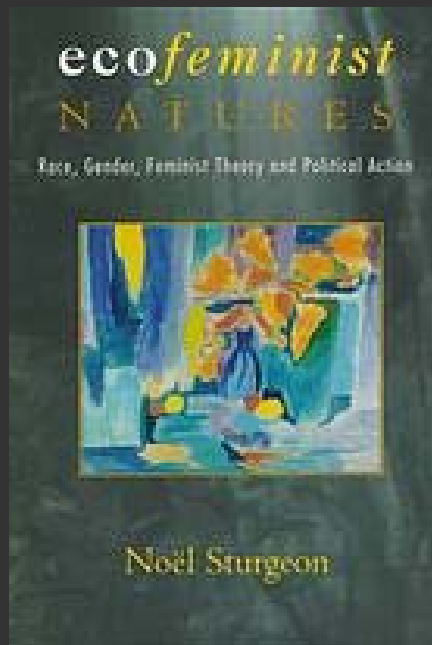

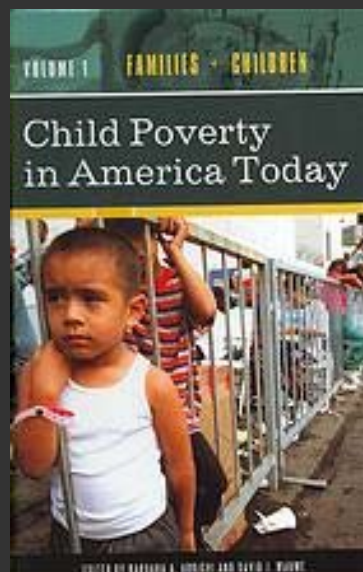

Class here institutions conferring degrees below the bachelor's level, two-year colleges

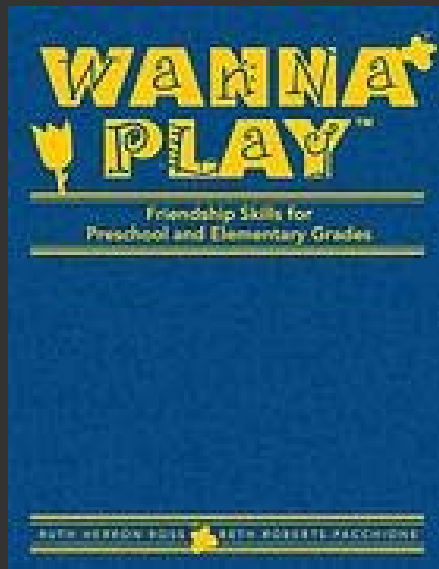

Subdivisions are added for all topics in heading together, for foreign languages alone, for official languages alone, for second languages alone

372.652-372.659 Specific foreign, official, second languages

Subdivisions are added for any or all topics in heading
Add to base number 372.65 notation 2-9 from Table 6,

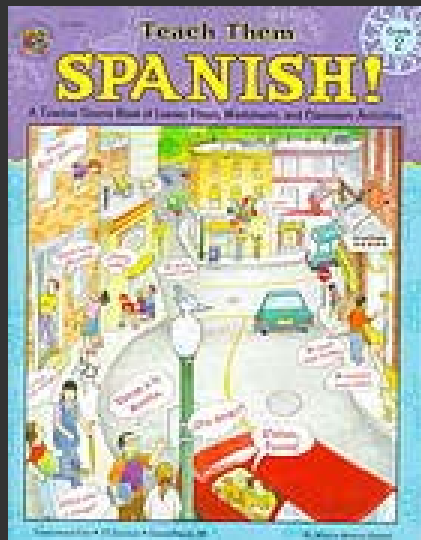
