(Option C: Class individual biography of men in 920.71; class individual biography of women in 920.72)

  - Table 2 –31-36 using add notes from Table 2 –4-6
  - Table 2 –368 Scandinavia
  - Table 2 –37 and –39 based on Roman provinces
- Added dates to headings
- Added option notes
- Clarified boundaries between Table 2 –3 and –4-6
